Position Overview:

The Lighting Designer will be responsible for designing, programming, and overseeing the implementation of the lighting for the production. This role is ideal for someone with experience in theatrical lighting design who enjoys working in a community theater setting.

Responsibilities:

- Collaborate with the director, set designer, and stage manager to develop a lighting concept that supports the production's artistic vision.
- Create a lighting plot and cue sheet based on script analysis and design discussions.
- Work with the technical director and production team to ensure proper setup and functionality of all lighting equipment.
- Attend production meetings, rehearsals (as needed), and all technical rehearsals.
- Program and operate the lighting board during tech rehearsals and performances (or train an operator if needed).
- Ensure that all lighting elements are safe and in working order.
- Make adjustments and troubleshoot issues as needed throughout the production run.

Qualifications:

- Experience in theatrical lighting design (community theater experience is a plus).
- Familiarity with lighting equipment, consoles, and software (e.g., ETC Ion, Nomad, etc.).
- Strong collaboration and communication skills.
- Ability to work within a budget and adapt to the theater's technical capabilities.
- Availability for tech rehearsals and performances.
